



SUPERMARKET – Stockholm Independent Art Fair celebrates 10 years

The artist-run art scene is in focus when SUPERMARKET – Stockholm Independent Art Fair celebrates 10 years, presenting a vital panorama of international contemporary art. SUPERMARKET 2016 will take place between 21–24 April at Svarta Huset (The Black House) at Telefonplan, Stockholm.

Since its beginnings in 2007, SUPERMARKET has established itself as a global platform for the artist-run art scene, a unique art project that brings together galleries and artists from all over the world. Every year SUPERMARKET focuses on a theme that highlights current issues and brings new perspectives to ongoing debates: in previous years the themes of Happiness and Difference have been aired and challenged, to name but two examples.

Over 60 artist-run galleries from more than 30 cities from all over the world will exhibit at Svarta Huset this year, including the performance gallery Galeria Raczej from Poznan in Poland, Intimnoe mesto and Luda Gallery from St Petersburg, and Mote 078 Gallery from Columbus in the United States.

Founders and Project Managers Andreas Ribbung, Meggi Sandell and Pontus Raud reflect on how Supermarket retains its vibrancy and edge:

“SUPERMARKET is an artist-run art fair that aims to highlight galleries and other initiatives run by artists. To celebrate our 10 year anniversary, we have chosen to just focus on the artist-run art scene, what has happened over the last 10 years and what it looks like today,” says Andreas.

“We are proud to be Scandinavia’s most international art fair and to provide a variety of artistic perspectives on contemporary societies”, says Meggi.

“Don’t miss the creative chaos generated by over 200 contemporary artists. SUPERMARKET is an experience like no other art fair in the world!” says Pontus.
