SUPERLOCAL 2020 Performance programme

How can we save the climate? Can machines become artists? What do we really share about ourselves with the outside world, and what always remains unspoken? Is it really the inside that counts?

SUPERLOCAL 2020 is the local version of SUPERMARKET – Stockholm Independent Art Fair. In this temporary transformation of the international art fair, the focus shifts from the global to the local. SUPERLOCAL 2020 Performance programme presents a selection of Stockholm-based artists with performances taking place on and off-stage.

Diana Agunbiade-Kolawole (GB/NG/SE) asks us how we are in her piece *I am fine, thank you. How are you?* The performance looks at how everyday conversations usually begin – what we tend to tell about ourselves and what remains unspoken. **Thursday 3 September**

On two occasions, the multimedia and performance artist **Gabriella Novak (SE)** will with the help of three remodeled robot vacuum cleaners and toy cars question the limits of creativity and art production in the performance *Will you still love me? part I + II*. **Friday 4 September and Saturday 5 September**

Heidi *ingentinget* Edström (SE) will perform her work *Det är insidan som räknas (It is the inside that counts)*. The artist will be moving around the venue exploring social encounters, contemporary cultural values and the boundaries between the internal and the external. **Thursday 3 September and Friday 4 September**

In his performance piece *Activities for Passing* **Henrik Green (SE)** offers simple solutions to the complex challenges within our contemporary society. The audience are encouraged to participate in a series of activities and reconnect with their senses in the times of information overload and climate anxiety. Gradually, the offered simple solutions are being questioned. **Thursday 3 September**

The Devourer of Hearts is a performance by artist **Imelda Cruz Linde (SE)** who suggestively combines spoken word, singing and music with mythology, fantasy and personal stories. **Saturday 5 September**

Stockholm-based music band **Hybris Healers (SE)** deliver a concert with a blend of neo-psychedelic sounds and melancholic tones. **Thursday 3 September**

Every day in their studio, the artist duo **Lundahl & Seidl (SE)** will show their latest work *Eternal Return/The Memor*, a collaboration with the British studio **ScanLAB Projects** and the architecture theorist **Malin Zimm**. The piece is an interplay of VR, live performance, objects, technology, music and radio that create a holistic experience for the body and all its senses. The work has been long-listed for this year's Lumen Prize. Pre-registration and meeting point is at SUPERLOCAL Info Point.

The artist- and curator-collective **Flat Octopus** present **AnnaLeena Prykäri (FI)** with her performance *From a Caretaker's archive: to be handled with aftercare* at SBG18, Swedenborgsgatan 18. **Thursday 3 September and Friday 4 September**



SUPERLOCAL 2020 Performance programme shows works by Stockholm-based artists on- and off-stage, and presents a wide range of performance art from durational works to interactive experiences and musical performance. The programme aims to offer a diversity of artistic expressions and provide a range of angles on the current topics and trends in contemporary art.
